

# LIST OF HUB MEMBERS WITH DESCRIPTIONS

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## Summary

One of the main goals of the Hypatia project is to establish national Hubs in each of the museum partners of the project. The five main partners started to establish their national Hub from the beginning of the project, following the guidelines and instructions given by the WP leader in the strategic plan for stakeholders' engagement (D3.2). The main partners were asked to present their experience in their National Hub establishment and their recommendations in the consortium meeting that took place in June, 2016 in Brussels. Following their recommendations, the BSMJ updated the strategic plan for stakeholders' engagement (D3.2) following additional recommendations from the main partners based on their experience. The nine third parties started to establish their national Hubs a few months afterwards, based on the revised version of the strategic plan for stakeholders' engagement (D3.2). A series of online meetings were held between the WP3 leader, NEMO, Ecsite and the third parties in order to provide additional support and clarifications to the third parties establishing their Hubs.

The teenagers' panels are acting as part of the National Hubs. Their contribution to the project, especially in the process of local adaptation of the Toolkit, was meaningful and significant. All main partners nominated a teenagers' panel moderator from their staff, recruited a group of teenagers (boys and girls) and arranged meetings and workshops in order to present the participating teenagers with the Hypatia project agenda; to test the Toolkits' activities and to get the teenagers' feedback. Some National Hubs invited members of the teenagers' panel to participate in their hub meetings.

Another role of the teenagers' panel was to serve as an editorial board for the Expect Everything campaign. Nemo's panel started this action on September, while the other partners will follow in the coming months.

The third parties have also started to establish their teenagers' panels. All of them have plans for recruiting the teenagers, most of them already nominated the teenagers' panel moderator. The Teknikens Hus (Sweden) has already recruited also the teenagers and will hold their first meeting by the end of October.

This report includes:

1. Information about each National Hub coordinator – his/her name, position and E-mail and a list of the Hub members with descriptions from all the 14 partners of the Hypatia project.
